The California Academy of Preventive Medicine (CAPM) is pleased to announce our strong support for your bill, SB 648, which was recently endorsed by our Board. Our Academy is the state medical specialty society for physicians practicing in the fields of public health and preventive medicine.

You have correctly identified yet-another effort by the tobacco industry to peddle its addictive toxins to our citizens. Clearly nicotine is the primary addictive substance of cigarettes which the industry is trying now to deliver to our residents in yet-another creatively profitable form. It is a harmful *drug* which they are now attempting to deliver through a *medical device* outside this nation and state's regulatory structures.
