- **Antibiotics in livestock** (Restriction to veterinary indications) **SB 27 (Hill)**
 - Support Level 1-2
 - Letters and visit to author, offer of testimony
 - 17 Sept., ENROLLED, **SIGNED by Governor**
 - **Cannabis, Medical** (Regulation of) **AB 26 (Jones-Sawyer)**
 - Support Level 1
 - Letter to author
 - This and other cannabis bills were reconfigured into 3 different bills (**AB266 [Bonta], AB 243 and SB 643**), see below
 - **Cannabis, Medical** (Regulation of) **AB 266 (Bonta, et. Alia.)**
 - Watch (not originally a CAPM bill), converted to Support Level 1
 - Letter to author. After became a package with AB 243 and SB 643, combined letter to Governor
 - Medical cannabis bills were reconfigured into a package of 3 different bills (**AB266 [Bonta], AB 243 and SB 643**), ENROLLED, **SIGNED by Governor**
 - **Drug Abuse, Awareness Month** (For prescription drugs) **ACR 26 (Levine)**
 - Support Level 1
 - Passed and signed rapidly, before active involvement
 - ENROLLED, **SIGNED by Governor**
 - **Immunizations** (Required for Day Care workers) **SB 792 (Mendoza)**
 - Support Level 1

- Letters to author, testimony at Assembly Health Committee
- 10 Sept., ENROLLED, **SIGNED by Governor**
- **Medi-Cal Reimbursements** (2 specialty visits/day Medi-Cal pay) **AB 858 (Wood)**
 - Support Level 2, converted to Watch after pay for 2 visits deleted
 - Letters to author
 - 18 Sept. ENROLLED, VETOED BY GOVERNOR (along with 5 other bills expanding Medi-Cal)
- **Sexual Health and HIV/AIDS** (Opt-in by parents before sex/HIV ed) **AB 517 (Gallagher)**
 - Oppose Level 2
 - Letter to author
 - Bill amended to eliminate opt-in requirement when outside educators; active opposition discontinued
 - Failed on floor of Senate 9 Sept., to INACTIVE FILE
- **Sugar sweetened beverages** (Warning labels) **SB 203 (Monning)**
 - Support Level 2
 - Calls, email to author, offer to help if revived in 2016
 - Bill died before active involvement. Now a 2-Year bill
- **Tobacco – special session** (Allow county tax on tobacco) **SBX2 9 / ABX2 19**
 - Support Level 1 for all six Tobacco – Special Session bills
 - Letters to authors
 - All 6 of these “Tobacco – Special Session” bills are stalled in the special Legislative Session awaiting actions by the Governor and Legislature to negotiate them all.
- **Tobacco – special session** (BOE licensing fee made annual) **SBX2 10 / ABX2 11**
 - Support Level 1 for all six Tobacco – Special Session bills
 - Letters to authors
 - All 6 of these “Tobacco – Special Session” bills are stalled in the special Legislative Session awaiting actions by the Governor and Legislature to negotiate them all.
- **Tobacco – special session** (eCigs regulated like tobacco) **SBX2-5 / ABX2 6**

 - 3 Sept., ENROLLED, **SIGNED by Governor**
- **Tobacco, Medical pay for cessation services** **AB 1162 (Holden)**
 - Support Level 1
 - Letters to author, testimony at Senate Health Committee
 - 18 Sept., ENROLLED, VETOED by Governor (along with 5 other bills expanding Medi-Cal)
- **Tobacco, regulation of eCigarettes** **SB 140 (Leno)**
